Learning Button Function

There is one learning button on the remote control. It can record any button's function on the other IR remote control.

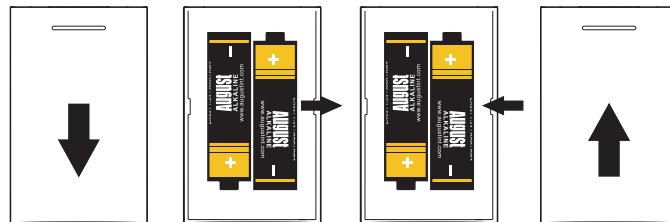
1. Press and hold the learning button for 6 seconds to active the learning function. Once activated, the status LED will light blue.
2. While activated, aim the desired IR remote control to the IR LED on the DVB600's smart remote control. As shown in the picture below.
3. Press the button to be recorded.
4. Once the recording has finished, the status LED will flashes 2 times

5. Battery Replacement

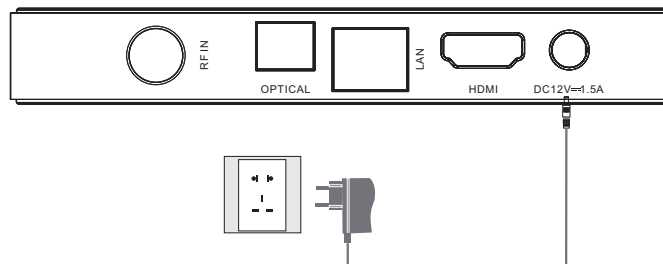


1. Press and slide the battery cover in direction shown.

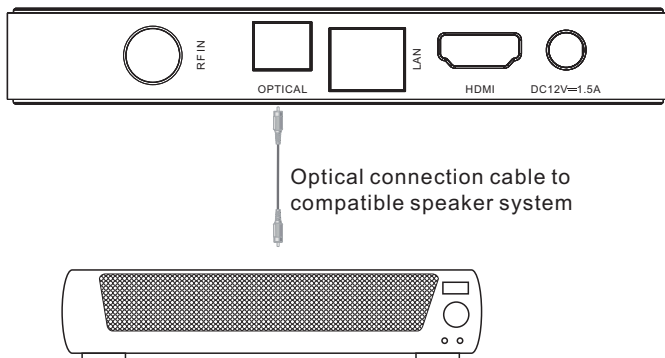
6.1 Power Adaptor Connection

1. Connect the power adaptor to the DC IN 12V socket.
2. Plug the power adaptor into the mains power socket.

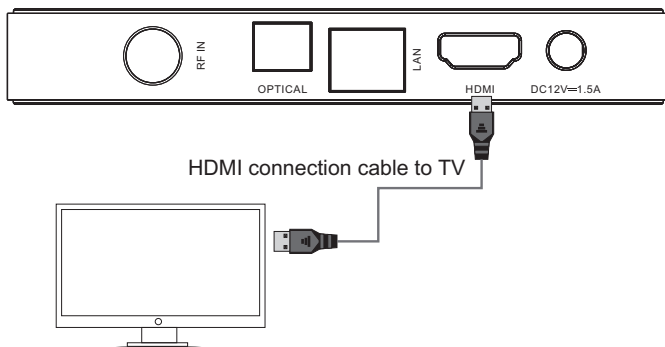


6.2 Audio Optical Output Connection

2. Insert the audio optical cable to the audio optical input on the receiver device.




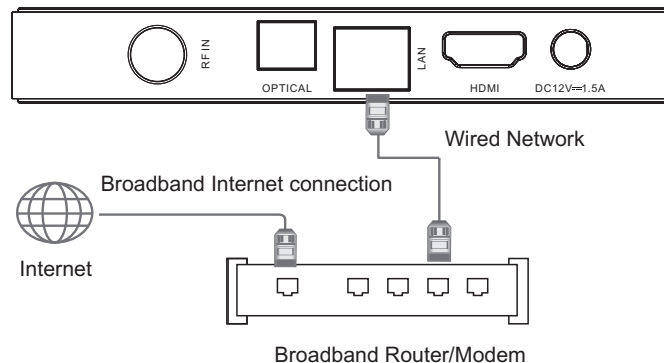
6.3 HDMI Output Connection



Once connected, select the input source on you TV to correct HDMI port.

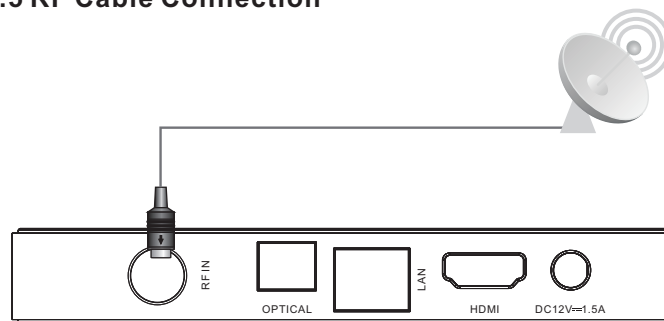
6.4 Ethernet Connection

1. Connect the DVB600 to your router using an Ethernet cable.
2. Select  from the home screen.
3. Select 'Advanced option'.
4. Select 'Proxy settings' and press <OK> to change the proxy hostname.
5. Select 'IP settings' and press <OK> to change the IP setting between DHCP and Static.



Note: If DHCP is enabled on your router, the DVB600 will automatically connect to the router once the Ethernet cable is inserted; If DHCP is not enabled on your router, you will need to manually input an IP address.

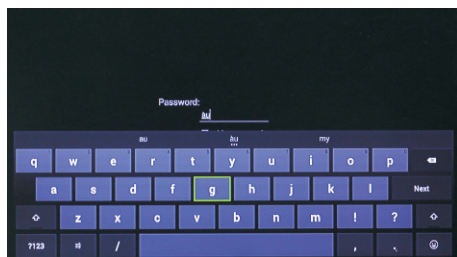
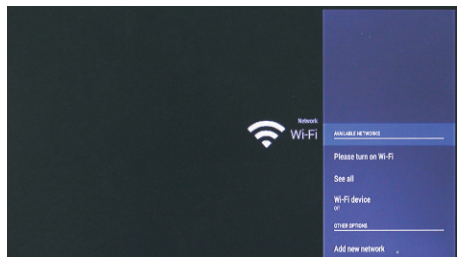


6.6 Wi-Fi Connection

The DVB600 is able to connect wirelessly to your router. Please note that, for video streaming, an internet bandwidth of at least 2Mbps is recommended. To stream HD movies from an internal network an Ethernet cable connection is recommended.

Note: The DVB600 will disable the Wi-Fi function when the Ethernet cable is inserted.

1. Select  from the home screen.
2. Under available networks, it will list three best signal network. Select 'See all' to see all the available networks.
3. Use <▲> or <▼> to select the network and press <OK> to confirm.
4. Enter the network password if requested.
5. Select 'Next' from the on screen keyboard to save and connect to the network.



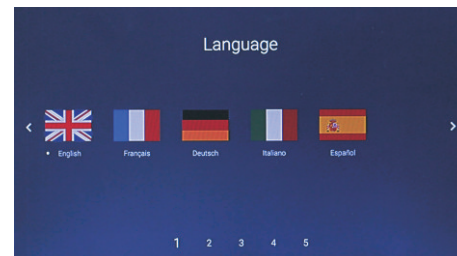
7. Operation

7.1 Initial Installation

Important: Ensure the satellite dish and the cables are properly installed to get the best signal.

A setup wizard will be run on the first time use of the DVB600. All the settings can be changed later.

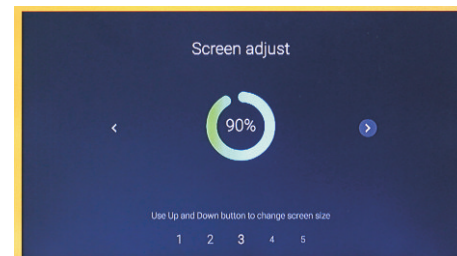
1. Use <◀> and <▶> to select your language and press <OK> to confirm.



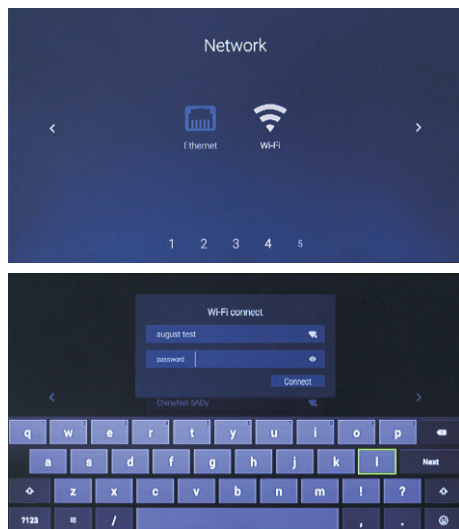
2. Use <▲> and <▼> to select the resolution and press <OK> to confirm.



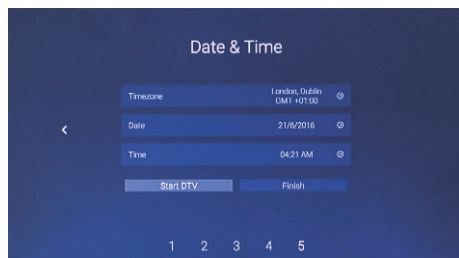
3. Use <▲> and <▼> to adjust the screen size and press <OK> to confirm.



4. Select the type of network connection. Press <OK> to confirm or change the settings for Wi-Fi network.



5. Use <▲> and <▼> to select between 'Timezone', 'Date' and 'Time', press <OK> to enter.



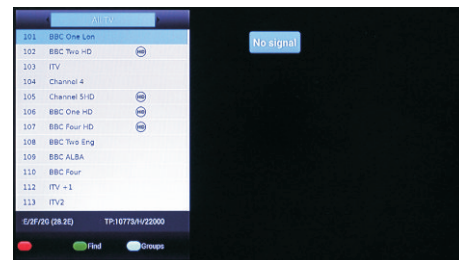
5.1. Use <▲> and <▼> to change the timezone and press <OK> to confirm.

5.2. Use <▲> and <▼> to change the date; Use <◀> and <▶> to change between year, month and day. Use <▶> to highlight 'Set' then press <OK> to confirm.

5.3. Use <▲> and <▼> to change the time; Use <◀> and <▶> to change between hour, minute and AM / PM. Use <▶> to highlight 'Set' then press <OK> to confirm.

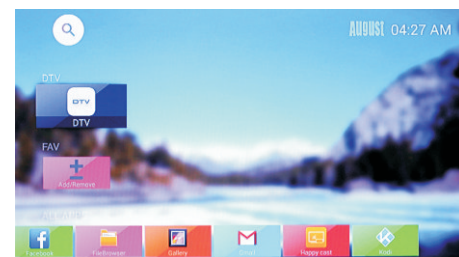
6. Select 'DTV' to finish the settings and start DTV; select 'Finish' to go to the home page. Press <OK> to confirm.

Note: Freesat Channels are pre-stored on the device and only require the satellite dish to be correctly installed. If your dish is oriented towards the Astra Satellite, you can select finish and go to the DTV App to start watching TV without having to perform a scan.



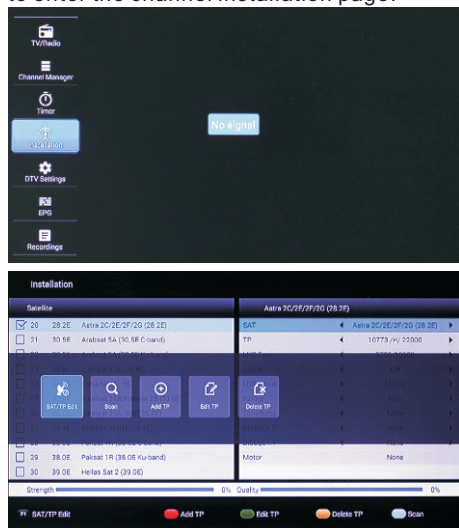
7.2 DTV

The DVB600 can be used to watch, record and playback satellite TV. To switch to DTV mode select 'DTV' from the home screen.



7.2.1 Channel Scan

If there are no channels saved on the DVB600, a channel scan will have to be performed. Select 'Installation' in the 'DTV' page and press <OK> to enter the channel installation page.



Press <F1> to list all operation

7.2.1.1 Satellite Selection

1. Use <▲> and <▼> to highlight the desired satellite from the left hand side of the screen. Detailed information will be displayed on the right hand side.
2. Press <OK> to select the desired satellite. The signal strength and quality status will be displayed at the bottom of the screen.



7.2.1.2 Quick Channel Scan

If you wish to use the default settings to perform an automatic channel scan, press <F1> to enter the 'Scan' options. Use <▲> and <▼> to highlight 'Press OK to scan' then press <OK>.



7.2.1.3 Adding a Transponder (TP)

Press <F1> to see the default frequency list and enter the 'SAT / TP Edit'.

1. Press <F1> to add a TP.

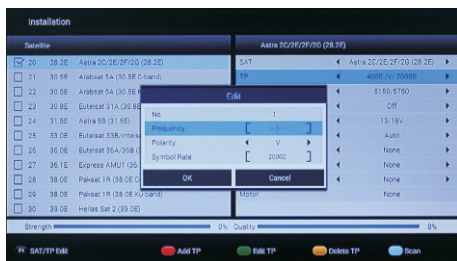


2. Use <▲> and <▼> to select the Frequency, Polarity and Symbol Rate.
3. Use the number pad to input the values for frequency and symbol rate.
4. Use <◀> and <▶> to change the polarity between V (Vertical) and H (Horizontal).
5. Once finished, select 'OK' or 'Cancel' and press <OK> to confirm.

Note: TP is in short for transponder. A transponder is a series of interconnected units that form a communications channel between the receiving and the transmitting antennas.

7.2.1.4 Editing a Transponder

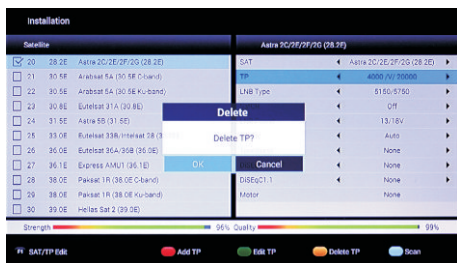
1. Use <▲> and <▼> to select a TP in the list.
2. Press the <●> to edit the TP.



3. Use <▲> and <▼> to select the Frequency, Polarity and Symbol Rate.
4. Use the number pad to input the values for frequency and symbol rate.
5. Use <◀> and <▶> to change the polarity between V (Vertical) and H (Horizontal).
6. Once finished, select 'OK' or 'Cancel' and press <OK> to confirm.

7.2.1.5 Deleting a Transponder

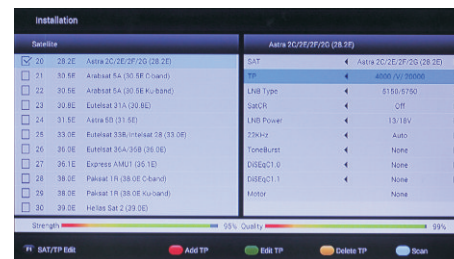
1. Use <▲> and <▼> to select a TP in the list.
2. Press <●> to delete the TP.
3. Select 'OK' or 'Cancel' and press <OK> to confirm.



Note: You can also use <◀> and <▶> keys to change TPs in the detailed page.

7.2.1.6 Options

To manually change the following options, use:



1. <▲> and <▼> to select one
2. Then <◀> and <▶> keys to change the settings

- LNB Type

Low Noise Block Downconverter. Change this setting to match the range of the converter.

- SatCR

Enable this to set the LNB to unique channel, if mutable receivers are using the same coax cable.

- LNB Power

Enable this to give power to the LNB to receive vertical channels only (13V), horizontal channels only (18V) or switch between vertical and horizontal.

- 22KHz

By turning the 22KHz option on and off, the receiver will automatically switch between the two ports allowing reliable operation that sometimes fails when using a 2X1 DiSEqC switch.

- ToneBurst

Adjust ToneBurst between none, A and B.

- DiSEqC1.0

This setting allows you to switch between up to 4 satellite sources.


- DiSEqC1.1

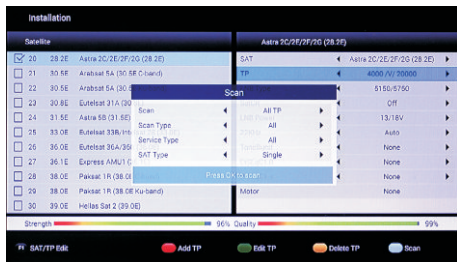
This setting allows you to switch between up to 4 satellite sources.

- Motor

If your satellite dish doesn't have a motor, this function will not be available.

7.2.1.7 Manual Channel Scan

1. Press <  > to perform a manual scan.
2. Some settings can be changed before performing the scan.
3. Use <▲> and <▼> to select and use <◀> and <▶> keys to change the settings.



- Scan

Select between:

- **All TP** to scan transponders which are in the receiver's database (Recommended)
- **Blind** to scan every possible frequency
- **One TP** to scan only the currently selected transponder
- **One TP + NIT** to scan the currently selected transponder and the Network Information Table by the satellite service provider.

- Scan Type:

Select between:

- **All** to save all scanned channels
- **FTA** to save only the free to air channels (Recommended)

- Service Type

Select between:

- **All** to save TV and Radio channels (Recommended)
- **TV** to save only TV channels
- **Radio** to save only radio channels

- SAT Type:

Select between:

- **Single** to search a single satellite
- **Multi** to search all selected satellite. Not available if only one satellite is selected on the left hand side of the screen.

4. Use <▲> and <▼> to select 'Press <OK> to Scan' then press <OK> to confirm. If you wish to exit press <  > and select 'OK', 'Exit' or 'Cancel'.

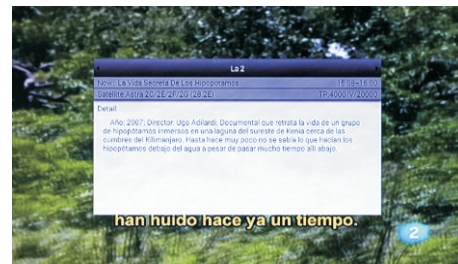
7.2.2 DTV Mode

7.2.2.1 Channel Information

Press <F3/INFO> in TV/Radio mode to show the "now and next program information" for the current channel/station including signal strength and quality. The display also shows whether subtitles and Teletext information are available.

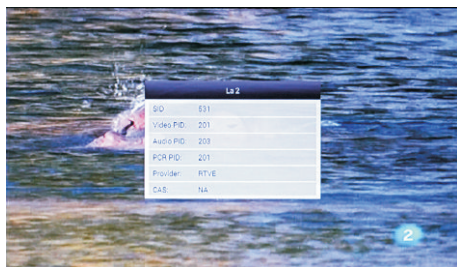


Press <F3/INFO> a second time to show detailed information.



Press <F3/INFO> a third time to show the satellite information for the current channel.

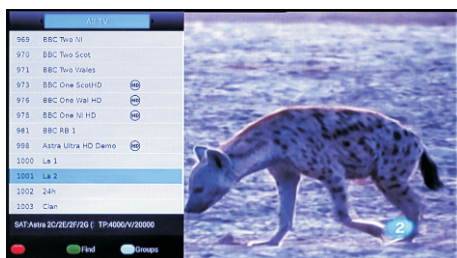
To close the channel information, press <F3/INFO> a last time. Alternately.



7.2.2.2 Channel List

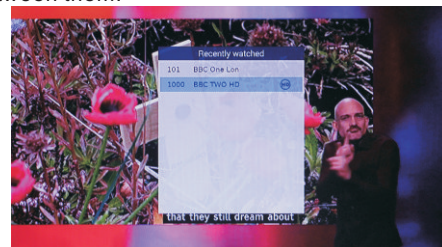
Press **<OK>** in the TV or Radio mode to show the channel list. Press **<TV/Radio>** to switch between the TV and Radio channel list. Press **<▲>** or **<▼>** to select the desired channel, then press **<OK>** to confirm.

Press **<⏮>** to close the list.



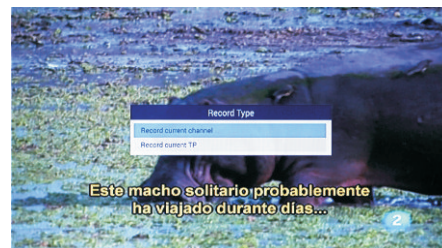
7.2.2.3 Recall

Press **<RECALL>** in TV or Radio mode to display recently watched channel list. Use **<▲>** or **<▼>** to select the channel then press **<OK>** to switch between them.



7.2.2.4 Record

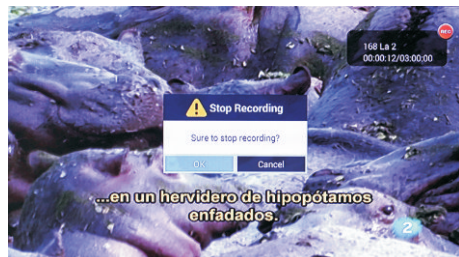
To record a program, a USB removable storage - such as USB stick or hard drive - with sufficient remaining space is required. Plug your USB removable storage into one of the USB sockets. Press **<F4/REC>** to start an instant recording of the program being watched using the pre-set PVR settings.



Press **<F4/REC>** again to show the recording details. This will also enable you to set the recording duration using the number keys and pressing **<OK>** to confirm.



To stop recording, press <■>.



Note: The recording settings can be changed in the DTV settings. Please refer to section 7.2.4.6.

7.2.2.5 Time Shift

To use Time a USB removable storage - such as USB stick or hard drive - with sufficient remaining space is required.

Press <▶II> to start Time Shift.



Press <▶II> to pause and resume the program.



Use <◀> or <▶> to jump the recording backwards or forwards by 30 seconds.

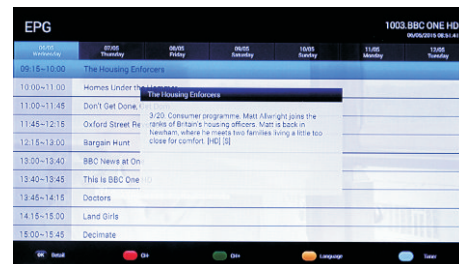
Press and hold the <◀> or <▶> for fast backwards or forwards.

Press <■> to end Time Shift.

Note: Time Shift settings can be changed in DTV Settings. Please refer to section 7.2.4

7.2.2.6 EPG

Press <F1/EPG> in TV mode or select EPG from the DTV home screen to view the Electronic Program Guide. This function only supports the program guide for the current and next program, scheduled viewing or scheduled recording of programs.



Press <■> to move to the next channel.

Press <■> to move to the previous channel.

Press <OK> to show the program information.

Press <▶II> to set the schedule options.

Note : Schedule options only apply on future programs.

- Select 'Record' to set a scheduled recording
- Select 'Cancel this' to cancel
- Press <OK> to confirm.



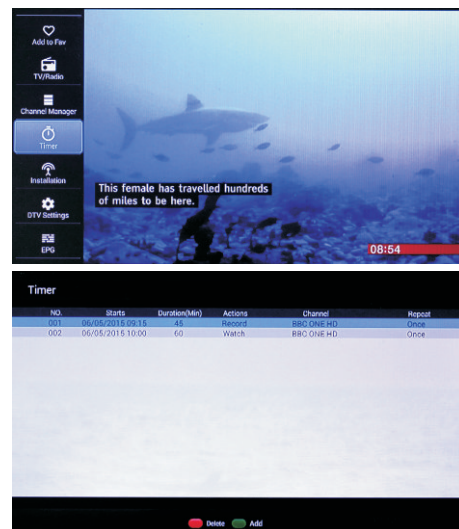
- Select 'Play' to set a reminder for viewing a future program
- Select 'Cancel this' to cancel
- Press <OK> to confirm.



7.2.2.7 Timer

Timer function allows scheduling recordings or reminders for viewing a future program.

1. Press <⏮> to show the menu list then use <▲> or <▼> to select 'Timer'. Press OK to enter.



2. Press <+> to add an event (action)
3. Use <▲> and <▼> to change between options:
 - Actions: use <◀> or <▶> to change between 'Record' and 'Watch'.
 - Repeat: use <◀> or <▶> to change between 'Once', 'Daily' and 'Weekly'.



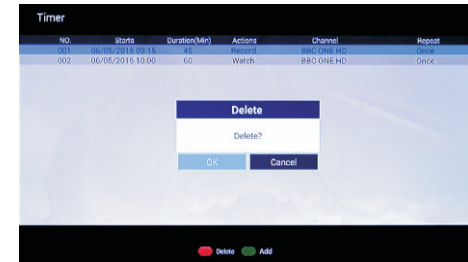


Note: When weekly repeat is chosen, select the day for which the reminder or recording should repeat. Use the arrow keys to select the day then press **<OK>** to confirm. Select 'Cancel' to return without saving or select 'OK' to save. The 'Repeat' will highlight the selected date.

4. Select 'Starts' then press **<OK>** to enter the start time. Use **<◀>** or **<▶>** to change between time and date, Use **<▲>** and **<▼>** to change the time and date. Select 'Cancel' to return or select 'OK' to save.



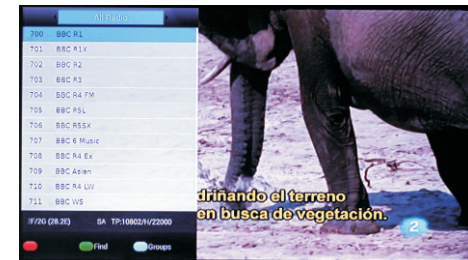
5. Select 'Duration (Min)' and use the number keys to change the duration.
6. Select 'Channel' and press **<OK>** to enter the channel list. Use **<▲>** and **<▼>** to change the channel or press **<Find>** to find a channel (search). Press **<OK>** to save.
7. Select 'Cancel' to return or select 'OK' to save the timer.
8. Press **<Delete>** to delete the current chosen timer



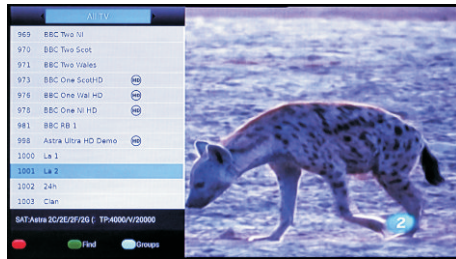

The default password is '0000'.

Press <TV/Radio> to change between TV and radio channel list.




Use <◀> and <▶> to change between groups, use <▲> and <▼> to select channel.

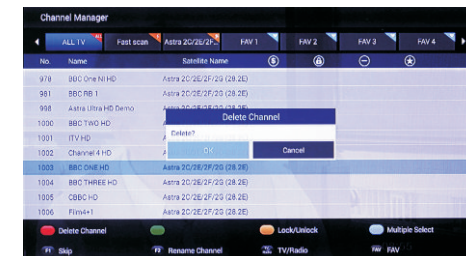
- Selecting Channels

Press <  > to switch between 'Single Select' and 'Multiple Select'.


Note: For multiple select: press <OK> to select individual channels to add to the multiple selection or press <F2> to select all.

- Deleting Channels

Press <  > to delete the selected channel(s). Select 'OK' to confirm or 'Cancel' to return.

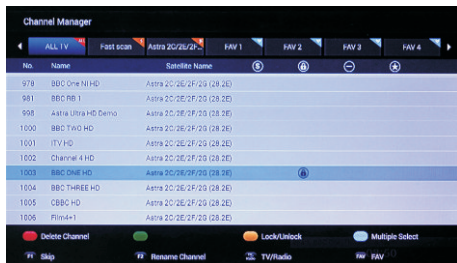



- Moving Channels

In single select mode press <  > to move a selected channel up. In multiple select mode, move the selected channel(s) to a highlighted point.


NOTE: It is recommended not to modify the Channel List in the UK as it may affect Freesat Channel N° and the working condition of the box.

- Locking a Channel




Press the yellow button to lock / unlock the selected channel(s). The icon  will show for the locked channel(s).

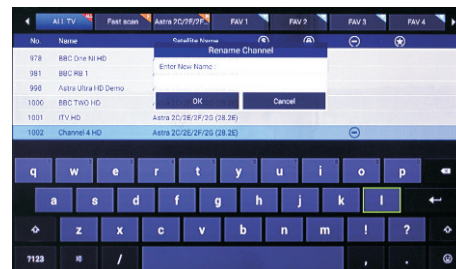

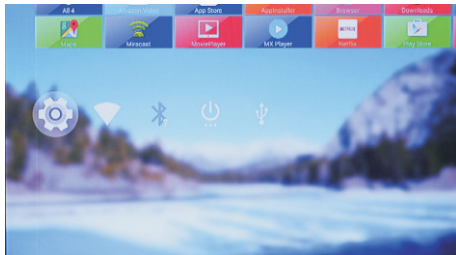
7.4.4 Miracast

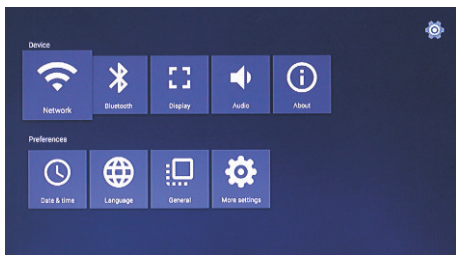
7.5.1 Quick Switch Between Apps

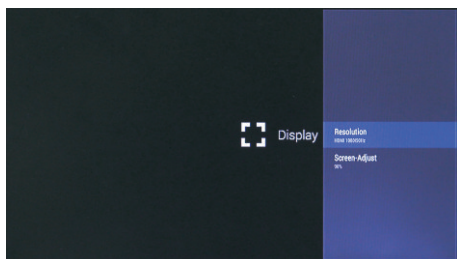
7.5.2.2 Bluetooth

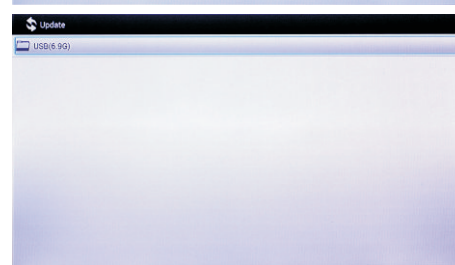
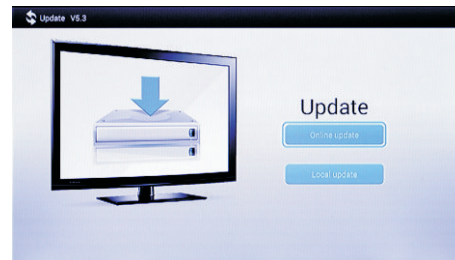
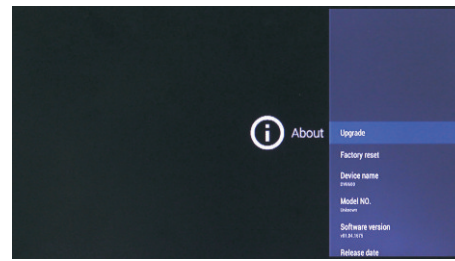
7.5.2.7 About

- **Online update** Select 'Online update' to check if there is a new update available on the server. If a new software version is available, follow the on screen steps to proceed on updating the software of your DVB600.

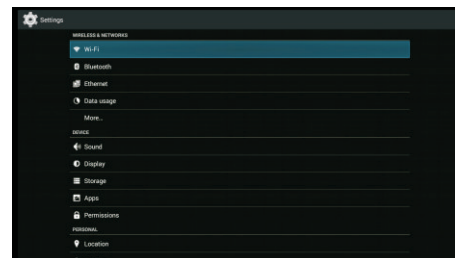
- **Local update** Local update enable you to update the software version from a local source such as SD card or USB stick:
